SCHEDULE

Brownland schooling shows consist of the warm-up day on Friday and the show on Saturday. Students are asked to come to the showgrounds straight from school on Friday. Once they get to Brownland, they will have the opportunity to ride and jump in the arena where they will be showing the next day. After they have ridden with their instructor, put their horse up for the night and cleaned their tack, they are free to leave for the evening. (They should be wrapped up no later than 6:30 or 7:00)

On Saturday, most students will need to be at the showgrounds by 7:00AM, check with your instructor for a definitive time. Show times will vary throughout the day and depend on the different classes or divisions that the student is entered in. Be prepared that there may be a lot of waiting! There are some concession stands on the showgrounds.

SHOW ATTIRE

Warm-Up Day:

- Polo with embroidered N.B. logo
- Hair neatly tied back
- Breeches with paddock boots and garters/half chaps

Show Day:

- Embroidered polo or show shirt (show jacket is optional)
- Jodphur breeches with garters and paddock boots
- OR -
- Breeches with black leather tall boots
- Show helmet or black velvet cover for schooling helmet
- Hair in hair net or neatly braided with ribbons
- Black show gloves (optional)
